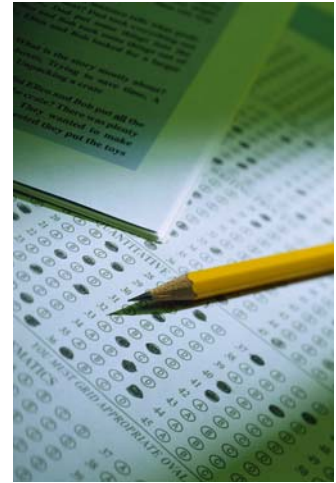

Exemption Criteria for Senior Exams:

Students in the third trimester of the twelfth grade are exempt from final exams, if they meet the following requirements:

1. The student must have a B+ average or better in an honors course or an A- or better average in a regular class.
2. Advanced Placement students electing not to take the AP exam will be accountable for a final exam in that class worth 20% of the final grade.
3. The student must not have any unexcused absences in the class.
4. The student must not have more than six (6) absences in the class. The student may not have rolled back any absences.
5. The student must not have more than four (4) tardies in the class.
6. The student must not have been issued any discipline referrals during his/her senior year.
7. The student shall be on track to graduate at the end of the twelfth trimester.
8. If a student is in the building while exams are taking place, he/she must be in a supervised area. If a student is not in a supervised area, he/she will have to take the exam, regardless of grade or attendance, or receive a "0" on his/her final exam which will be averaged into his/her trimester grade.

Final exams for seniors will be given Thursday, May 24 – Friday, May 25, 2012. Exams will be held in the gym.

ROBOTICS TEAM NEWS:

The Linden High School *FIRST* robotics team 3568, the RoboEagles, qualified for the Michigan State Championship on April 12-14. This is only the second year for the RoboEagles and we had a very successful year taking home the state trophy for cooperation. Cooperation is the willingness and ability to help not only your alliance teammates, but also your opposition as a show of gracious professionalism. We demonstrated this to the judges by our actions on the field as well as off. We loaned tools, parts and support to several of the other teams competing. We ended the year ranked 50th out of 193 Michigan teams. We were also the smallest team at the championship.

The *FIRST* Robotics Competition is often called the ultimate varsity sport of the mind. At its core, it is a mentoring program where high school students discover the merits of preparing themselves for higher education in technology and engineering while building a robot with the help of engineers and mentors.

The robotics team is currently fundraising to pay for the cost of the championship and our registration fees for next year. Anyone that is interested in the robotics team can stop by E109 (Ms. Miller's room) on any Wednesday for a meeting. We are done competing for the year, but have several other activities planned for the remainder of the school year and summer.
