

# SPANISH I & II

This is a guide to all the chapters that we will cover this year. There are two final exams; one in December and one in May/June. They are the same exams given at the High School. In order to receive High School credit 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade students must receive a 72% on both final exams.

## **Each chapter is graded upon the following:**

1. Vocabulary list/ or index cards –10 pts. Vocab lists are always due 2 days after we take the test. 2 pts extra credit will be given for those who write out vocabulary on index cards and labeled properly with current chapter. Furthermore, save all vocab lists once they have been passed back to you and graded. This will be an **excellent study tool** to assist you with preparing for final exams.
2. Workbook packet = 30-40 pts. Due on the day before or on test day.
3. Review (Repaso) = 20-25 pts. This review is at the end of each chapter.
4. Various activities out of text and additional assignments. 50-100pts.
5. Vocabulary Quizzes 20-50 pts.
6. Test 80-100 pts.

\*Please bring a # 2 pencil for all tests and quizzes. You are responsible for making an appointment with me to make up any test or quiz within 3 days of missing an exam or quiz. Check the absent binder when you are absent, and place absent work in appropriate bins on front desk. Late work is NOT accepted!

Rather than giving you a final exam at the end of each trimester I will give two final exams. The first is scheduled in **December**, and the second in **May/June**. The first final exam will cover the first 4 chapters of text, then the 2<sup>nd</sup> final exam will primarily test on the new four chapter from January- May with concepts learned earlier as well.
